Mayor Haroff opened the meeting at 6:31 p.m.

1. ROLL CALL

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

Angela Curley (Larkspur) discussed her involvement with the Beautification of Magnolia Project
and her plan to create a Larkspur Native Plant Corridor along Magnolia.

4. APPROVAL OF THE CONSENT CALENDAR

- 4.1 Introduce and Waive Second Reading and Adopt Ordinance 1019 Extending
the Existing, Voter-Approved Local City of Larkspur Sales Tax at the Three-
Quarter Cent Rate for the Continued Maintenance of City Services such as
Street, Road and Pothole Repair.

A member of the public requested Item 4.1 be removed from the Consent Calendar for
discussion.

City Manager Schwarz explained that at the July 19, 2017 City Council meeting, Council adopted
Resolution 56/17 placing the Larkspur Street Repair and Essential Services Measure on the
November 2017 ballot. Today, Council is asked to adopt Ordinance 1019.

James Holmes (Larkspur) spoke during public comment.

Council discussed and made three administrative changes to the ordinance.

Upon motion by Councilmember Hillmer, seconded by Councilmember Morrison, Ordinance 1019,
as amended, extending the existing, voter-approved local City of Larkspur sales tax at the three-
quarter cent rate was approved. The motion passed unanimously.

City Manager Schwarz gave his oral report to the City Council.

Councilmember Chu reported on the Town of Corte Madera and City of Larkspur Shared Fire
