CITY OF LARKSPUR NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING

SMOKE-FREE HOUSING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Larkspur shall hold a public hearing to introduce and waive the first reading of an Ordinance amending various sections of Chapter 6.16, "Prohibiting Smoking in Public Places, Places of Employment, Other Areas, and Multi-Unit Housing" of the Larkspur Municipal Code. The proposed ordinance would require, within one year after the ordinance is adopted and effective, that 100% of units in multi-unit housing, whether rental or common interest, be designated nonsmoking. There would be no exemption for the smoking of cannabis, including for medical purposes, in all units of multi-unit properties. The proposed ordinance maintains the existing provisions related to designation of a portion of an unenclosed common area as a designated smoking area, provided that the area meets criteria outlined in Section 6.16.020(B)(5) of the Larkspur Municipal Code. The proposed ordinance would also allow for enforcement by administrative citation and includes minor amendments to make the existing ordinance consistent with state law.
