SPECIAL MEETING

Mayor Hillmer called the special meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

1. ROLL CALL

Councilmember Haroff made a motion, seconded by Mayor Hillmer, not to provide an extended expiration date for temporary parklet permits and to direct staff to take steps to establish a parklet policy for consideration by the Council. The vote was 2-3 (Haroff and Hillmer in favor; Candell, Paulson, and Way opposed).


Upon motion by Vice Mayor Paulson, and seconded by Councilmember Candell, the Council continued the discussion on parklets to a date to be determined to discuss temporary standards before the June 30, 2022, expiration date for the temporary parklet permits. The vote was unanimously in favor.
